

Production and Test Technician

Job Description

Reporting directly to the Production Supervisor, the successful candidate will work within a small team and be responsible for the production of all technical engineering production components.

Key Responsibilities:

To assemble and test the production components listed below according to the production orders issued :

- Power Packs
- Filters
- Valves
- Piston Accumulators
- Diaphragm Accumulators
- Manifold Assemblies

To assist in other production duties as required e.g.

- Picking of components to job ticket
- Filling out 'work in progress' labels
- Clean components using MecWash washing machine
- Etch components using Auto-air etching machine
- Assemble items to the correct assembly procedure as required
- Test and flush items to the correct test procedure as required using HMG
- Generate certification packages all quality/test documentation and sign off ready for final QA sign off
- Stamping of release note with either 'personal number' stamp or 'assembly inspected' stamp and dating upon completion of work
- Packing of finished items, marking boxes if required for final packing by supervisor or stores person.
- To clearly label any components rejected during assembly
- To enter reject component information on to the weekly reject form and pass to Production Controller
- To ensure all work produced is to the minimum current Quality Assurance standards and is in line with the relevant HYDAC work procedures
- To fill out timesheets for all production work, as required and ensure work is carried out in line with production access schedule database within specified timescales
- SAP use may be required to check stock and bin locations, drawings, etc.

Essential Requirements:

- Experience of working within a Production Environment
- Experience of working with quality procedures
- Mechanically minded
- Ability to use manual handling equipment
- Ability to follow instructions/procedures
- Ability to work under pressure and to deadlines
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Ability to work with basic hand tools
- Computer literate
